



Early Childhood Teacher Guide for:

Easy Translator

The Ingenio Bilingual Easy Translator can be played independently or in small groups. Suggestions for using the game in collaborative play are also provided. Not all states have pre-K learning standards. We have chosen standards that can be found in New Jersey and/or Pennsylvania for pre-K and Kindergarten, and the national Head Start Child Outcomes framework. Using new words in context helps children learn to pronounce and use the words with meaning. Embedding Bilingual Easy Translator activities into the daily curriculum activities will support learning in two languages for all domains.

Home connections: Have extra sets of this game available in your home/school library so families can borrow them to practice vocabulary and English/Spanish skills at home.

Teacher reflections: Did all of the children learn the needed concepts in both languages? When should these activities be repeated? What other concepts and standards have been supported by using this game?
